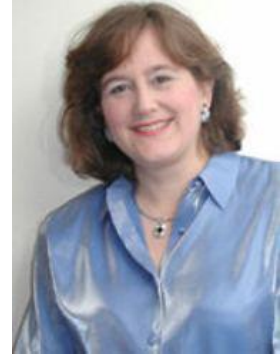

Bend your Line and a Right & Left Thru,

Slide Thru, Square Thru Three hands,

Swing your corner, Promenade

And if it's RSVP,

This is what I'll reply.
