Swing the corner and you all Promenade,
Some sing out loud on the telephone wire,
And some just clap their hands.

Break Lyrics:

The dogs and the cats, they take up the middle,
While the honeybee hums and the cricket fiddles,
The donkey brays and the pony neighs,
And the old coyote howls,

Closer: (Sides Face Grand Square)

Listen to the top where the little birds sing,
On the melody with the high notes ringing,
The hoot owl hollers over every-thing,
And the jay bird dis-a-grees – Allemande and Weave,
All God's critters got a place in the choir,
Swing your girl Promenade I cry,
Some sing out loud on the telephone wire,
